Eligibility: The Regatta is open to all boats of the V-32 Class whose owners are current members of AMYA or their national authority. Other entrants may be invited consistent with AMYA Guidelines and objectives.

Entry: Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached entry form and submitting it prior to August 9, 2015 with the entry fee indicated on the entry form. Entries received after the entry time period may be accepted with no guarantee of requested 75 MHZ channel.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions and frequency assignments will be sent to all competitors by email at the conclusion of the entry time period.

Racing Format: Racing will be conducted under the US SAILING, Racing Rules of Sailing as modified by Appendix E. The Race Committee will determine the number of races after considering weather, course and equipment conditions. We plan to run at least 14 races and the minimum number of races to make this an official AMYA event is 6.

Scoring: This regatta will be scored in accordance with the Low Point Scoring System as set forth in Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing. For each six (6) races sailed, one (1) worst score will be excluded from the overall score.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) finishers in the regatta. If there are fifteen entries or more we will award five (5) prizes.

Schedule of Events: The regatta will be held at Delco Park, 1700 Woodman Center Drive, Kettering, Ohio.
